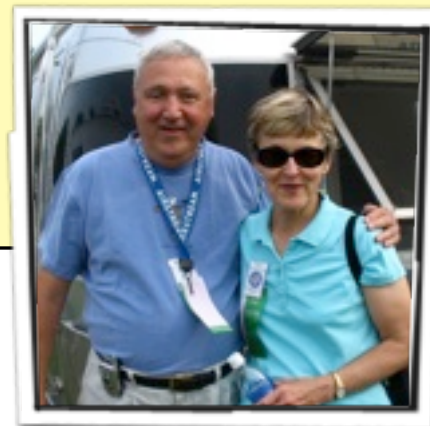

Will Rogers, who died in a 1935 plane crash, was one of the greatest political sages this country has ever known. Some of his sayings:

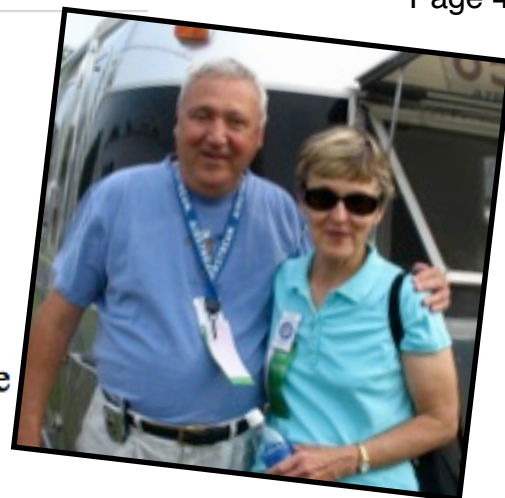
1. Never slap a man who's chewing tobacco.

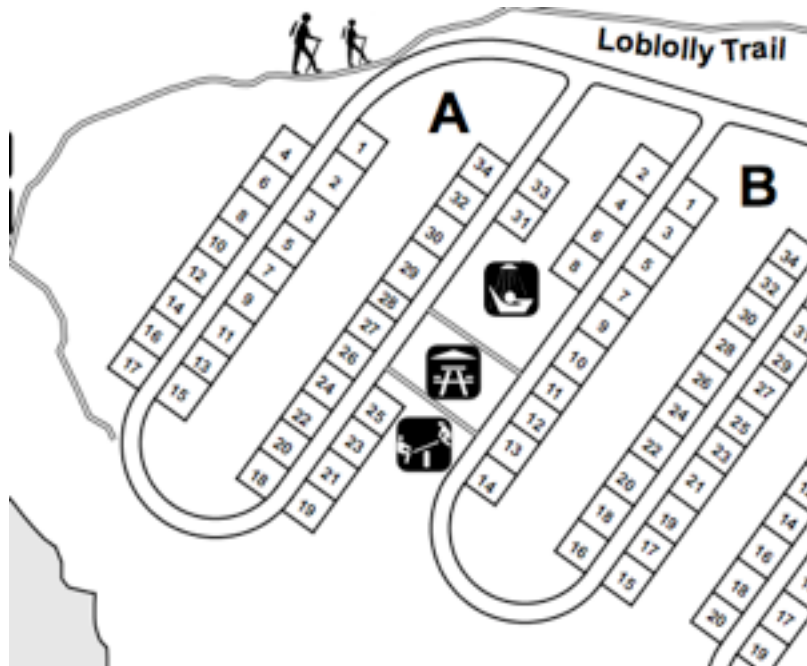
